

With four other DAC's ranging from similar to almost double the price of the 300D, I kept switching between one DAC and another while the staff members listened, not knowing what they were listening to. The vote was unanimous on "DAC C" having the most open and least "digital" sound. A couple of the staff writers were disappointed that they consistently picked the MOON 300D over their own DAC's, but that's how the chips fell.

With internal upsampling using 24-bit/352.8kHz processing, the MOON 300D will reproduce your digital music in a life-like fashion. This DAC will accept an input signal on any input except USB, (the USB input on the MOON 300D accepts a digital audio signal of up to 16-bits/48kHz. This is the native specification of the USB input.) ranging from 44.1 to 192kHz, with a bit-depth range from 16 to

It's interesting to note that MOON does not consider the USB "the best solution for high resolution digital playback" and chose to focus their efforts on the intrinsic advantages of other digital inputs. MOON opted to provide the best possible power supply, D/A converter and analog stage in the 300D at this price point. Keep in mind that USB was never intended for use with hi-resolution audio; there are latency issues which compromise sound quality (i.e. jitter and phase errors, etc.).







Martin Logan has long been regarded as one of the finest electrostatic speakers available anywhere at any price. Martin Logan has grown from a small specialty manufacturer in Lawrence, Kansas to a multinational manufacturer with a global presence. The steady evolution of their electrostatic speakers over the decades has resulted in a mature and refined product that doesn't take up the same large silhouette or imposing physical footprint of its predecessors. The ML design team has been able to achieve improved lateral dispersion enabling a wider listening window and more stable impedance characteristics make it much easier to drive.

Their latest effort is the Ethos, a speaker that has been refined and sculpted into a speaker worthy of the highest accolades, yet doesn't make you change your listening positions or amplifier choices. Now this is progress.
